What is a material?

A material is anything that is used to make things.

For example, wood, metal, fabric or rock.





Some materials can be recycled. This means they can be used again to make new things.

Materials have different properties. This means they behave in different ways.

Objects are made from materials.

For example ...

A wooden table is made from the material wood.





Vocabulary

Material- A material is what an object is made from.

Wood- A strong, hard material that comes from trees.

Metal- A solid material that is shiny.

Plastic- A strong, light material.

Fabric-Fibers woven together.

Rubber- A strong, waterproof, elastic material.

Property- Characteristics of a material.

Opaque- Does not allow light to pass through.

Transparent- Allows light to pass through it.

Absorbent- A material that can soak up water.
